

ASSINIBOIA MINOR BALL ASSOCIATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1. Two registration nights:
 - a. Wednesday, March 13 from 5:30 to 7:00 at the Curling Rink Lobby.
 - b. Wednesday, March 27 from 5:30 to 7:00 at the Curling Rink Lobby.
2. Registration form is attached.
3. Please note that there is an **additional fee of \$25** for registrations **after March 27**.
4. Also note that April 15 is the deadline to register. After that, there is no guarantee that we can accept additional players.
5. Uniform deposits of \$100 per player (separate post-dated cheques per player) are required for all but the Tykes, Pre-Rookie and Rookie.
6. For next year, we are requiring that for hygienic reasons, all players purchase their own batting helmet. It is wise to purchase the face mask at the same time.
7. The ball typically flies off an aluminum bat at a much higher rate of speed than a wooden bat. For player safety, baseball is generally moving away from the use of aluminum bats. It is already mandatory for certain leagues and some provincial playoffs. As Sask. Baseball moves to wooden bats only, AMBA will not be providing wooden bats for players. Please be prepared for that move.

FUNDRAISING INFORMATION

The last couple of years, we have not had any fundraisers. We have tried to keep registrations low, so this year, we are requiring each family participating in minor ball to sell one Softball Saskatchewan Cash Calendar. Calendars cost \$25 each, and instead of moving money back and forth throughout the year, we are going to add the \$25 to the price of registration (ONLY PER FAMILY).

For example: If you have one child playing minor ball, make out your cheque for that amount, plus \$25. If you have three children playing minor ball, you make out your cheque for the total of the three registrations, plus \$25.

When the calendar for your family arrives, you either:

- Keep it for yourself and send in the tear-off portion so that your name gets in the draws for the cash.
- OR**
- Sell it to someone else, keep the \$25, and send in the tear-off portion so that the buyer's name gets in the draws for the cash.

There are numerous draws throughout the year, with prizes from \$100 to \$1000 and the total prize pool is \$10 200.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

As a parent, I agree:

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
3. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
